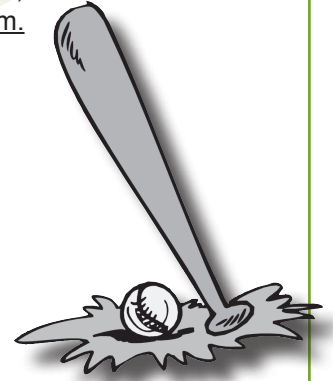
TRYOUTS:
